## Road Report 2020

Lansing Township has 32.5 miles in total. 28 gravel and 4.5 blacktop.

 $\frac{1}{2}$  mile of blacktop was laid this year between 12<sup>th</sup> Ave and 31<sup>st</sup> St. It was paid for by the Seven Springs III Association and it meets 10-ton road.

Last year we put on 3300 ton of crushed rock and was applied at a cost of \$46,000 or \$13.90/ton. There were 2 bids: Falk and Paulsen which was just pennies apart. We awarded Falk the 2020 bid, St Ansgar for rock and trucking. The rock is applied in June, after a couple of blading. The chloride is applied at  $\frac{1}{2}$  rate, all driveways receive 300'.

There were 2 bids on ditch mowing. RDS had the lower bid, June & September. We are hoping because last fall was dry and not much snow this winter that soft sports will not be a problem this spring. Therefore, we hopefully can cut back on rock and do some blacktop repair in Turtle Creek Estates.

Last year we seen an increase of garbage in the ditches. If you see someone doing this, please call a Board member or get the license of the vehicle.

Blade hours was 350 in 2020, less because of less snow.

We will have bids for spraying ditches this year, we do this every other year.
