

**RESOLUTION: 81820
LANSING TOWNSHIP
MOWER COUNTY, MINNESOTA**

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN ANIMAL BOUNTY IN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, Minn. Stat. §§ 348.12, 348.125, and 348.13 authorize towns to offer a bounty for the destruction of pocket gophers;

WHEREAS, the town board determines pocket gophers constitute a nuisance to property, particularly property being used for agricultural purposes;

WHEREAS, the town board determines it is in the best interests of the public to establish a bounty to encourage the destruction of pocket gophers in the township;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of Lansing Township establishes a bounty on pocket gophers in the township to be conducted as follows:

1. The bounty shall only apply to pocket gophers that were, to the satisfaction of the town board clerk, captured and killed within the boundaries of the township, by a Lansing Township resident.
2. To be eligible for collection of the bounty on a pocket gopher, both front feet of pocket gophers must be presented to the town board clerk.
3. The person claiming a bounty must provide the town his or her name, address, and the location of where the animals were killed/captured by the township resident.
4. The amount of the bounty shall be Four Dollars (\$4.00) per gopher (both front feet).


