November 16, 2021

Water: scada panel checked into by Pyromex, and Fox Electric, waiting for tech man because no communication with the scada panel, bacteria/fluoride samples were good, McCarthy Well – well pump is good. 420,500 gallons for October. Lynn Allas requested looking into grants to obtain lights/motion detection cameras/new well for secondary use.

Road Committee Report: Gary Braaten reported Bernie Boverhuis had been out blading, and that Kyle Johnson agreed to trip trees Wednesday/Thursday
